

Code of Conduct

We are committed to fostering a welcoming, safe, and inclusive environment for all participants. This Code of Conduct applies to all attendees, speakers, sponsors, exhibitors, media, other partners, Mobidictum employees and event staff involved in any Mobidictum event or community activities.

Our Commitment

Mobidictum is dedicated to ensuring that our events are safe spaces for everyone, with a zero-tolerance policy on harassment of any kind. We are committed to providing a friendly and supportive environment for all participants, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, ethnicity, age, financial situation, physical appearance, or abilities. This commitment extends to all employees and staff members. We expect everyone to work together to maintain a respectful and harassment-free experience.

Unacceptable Behaviour

Unacceptable behaviours include, but are not limited to:

- Intimidating, harassing, abusive, discriminatory, derogatory, or demeaning conduct.
- Offensive verbal comments about gender, sexuality, ethnicity, age, or physical appearance.
- Disrespect towards cultural or religious practices, such as offensive comments or gestures that disregard religious attire or norms.
- Deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of sessions or other event activities, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention.
- Physical, written, verbal, or any other form of abuse, threats, harassment, or intimidation that disrupts the peace or creates an unsafe or uncomfortable environment for others.
- Any unlawful acts or behaviours that disturb the peace or offend others.

This commitment is particularly important given Turkey's diversity of cultures and backgrounds. We understand the significance of respect for social norms, cultural sensitivities, and shared values within the Turkish context and aim to promote an environment where everyone feels welcome and valued.

This Code of Conduct is also designed with the scale of our events in mind, which may include thousands of attendees. With such high capacities, we are committed to ensuring that every individual, whether in a large gathering or a more intimate setting, experiences a safe and positive environment.

Consequences of Unacceptable Behaviour

Participants or staff members asked to stop unacceptable behaviour expected to comply immediately. Mobidictum reserves the right to take any action deemed necessary, including but not limited to expulsion from the event or activity without warning refund, or disciplinary action against staff, should anyone engage in unacceptable behaviour. This includes any behaviour that compromises the safety or harmony of the event, especially in large crowds where minor disruptions can quickly escalate.

Reporting Unacceptable Behaviour

If you witness or experience any form of harassment or inappropriate behaviour, please report it immediately to any event staff member or designated safety team. Any Mobidictum team member can help you contact the safety team.

Cultural Sensitivity & Event Environment

We ask all attendees to be particularly mindful of cultural differences and to avoid any behaviours that may be considered offensive in Turkey. This includes consideration of dress code, public behaviour, and respect for Turkish social norms, especially in the presence of local attendees.

We also recognize that our event's scale—drawing thousands of participants from different cultures—can create unique challenges. In such large settings, we must maintain respectful conduct in crowded spaces, ensuring personal boundaries are respected and everyone feels comfortable.
